


Welcome Aboard Her Majesty's Airship, The Royal Victoria

The Wireless Telegraph: The *Royal Victoria* is equipped with a state of the art wireless telegraph. If you need to send a message ashore, please contact the Purser.

Firearms: For safety reasons, we ask that all firearms be turned over to the Purser upon boarding for safekeeping during the voyage. They will be returned to you when you disembark.

Safety: The *Royal Victoria* was designed to be unsinkable by the same naval engineer that built the *Titanic*! No finer vessel has ever been in the air. As the vessel is literally unsinkable, the Captain has dispensed with the nuisance of safety drills.
